

A4S SERVICES OFFERED

A4S GROUP Mentoring

Student-centred group learning (Min. 1 mentor/3 learners), with focus on: developing confidence & self-esteem; engagement; identifying and developing strengths; learning to help/mentor others; and achieving OCN or BTEC accreditation. We will always try and encourage discussion about future possibilities and steer young people towards progression routes.

A4S.121 INDIVIDUAL Mentoring

Student-centred 121 mentoring, where the young person requires individual attention. This can be alongside a group learning situation (where possible, in terms of behaviour and capability) or just 1-2-1, mentor + mentee. Same goals as above.

A4S.121 INTENSIVE INDIVIDUAL Mentoring

Student-centred 121 mentoring, where the young person has complex circumstances and requirements that necessitate strictly 121 mentoring, with a regular mentor, and where additional support outside of the mentoring sessions is required, e.g. multi-agency meetings to discuss progress and on-going requirements. Same goals as above.

A4S OUTCOMES & PROGRESSION ROUTES

A4S OCN Improving Own Learning & Performance

Whichever outdoor activity is chosen, each learner who joins the Angling4Success programme for 7 Weeks+ will complete the Level 1 OCN I.O.L.P. accreditation. In doing so, the learner records learning experiences and gains a better understanding of how to optimise his/her future learning in the classroom/training/at work. Level 2 OCN IOLP also available.

New for 2010/2011 A4S NOCN Functional Skills

For those young people who need additional Support in English, Maths & ICT, we can incorporate into the Angling4Success 121 programme, activities and projects that address these skill requirements and offer NOCN accreditation to help achieve nationally recognised qualifications. We have found that those young people who fight against being in the classroom can be much more open to paperwork in an outdoor setting. Relate it to an existing hobby & the chance of engagement are increased.

Angling4Success BTEC 1st Certificate in Fish Husbandry (2 GCSE Equivalent - Grades A-C)

In 2009/2010, young people from Bedfordshire & Northants successfully completed the Angling4Success Level 2 BTEC 1st Certificate in Fish Husbandry course. For 1 day a week x 30 weeks (180 Hrs) young people learn: Angling Skills (60 Hrs); Fishery-related Practical Land-based Skills (60 Hrs) & Fishery Industry-related Experience (60 Hrs).
