Car park and cars.	Participants and coaches.	Low.	Safety talk and constant supervision.	Park near to lakes, walk on sides of roads. Be aware.
Drowning. (Deep water.)	Participants and coaches.	Low to medium.	Safety talk and constant supervision. First aid kit. Throw ropes carried by coaches. Life rings round lakes.	Gripped wellies or boots to prevent slipping in. Coaches to have throw ropes on or near them at all times. Coaches to know where the liferings are. Coaches to constantly keep an eye on the participants.
Person hooking themselves.	Participants and coaches.	Low to medium.	Safety talk. First aid kit.	Use barbless hooks. Always have disgorgers / forceps and an experienced coach ready.
Banksides and platforms. (Especially slippery when very wet or icy.) Some platforms with odd damaged or broken slats, and odd nail poking out.	Participants and coaches.	Low to medium.	Safety talk and constant supervision.	Gripped boots or wellies. Take time and plenty of care and attention when moving around. Do not use swims with broken platforms or damaged slats. No messing about.
Wells disease and bugs.	Participants and coaches.	Low.	Safety talk and constant supervision.	Make sure no cuts or open wounds, especially on hands. (If there are, make sure suitably protected.) Wash hands thoroughly before eating and after fishing.
