## **Specific Risk Assessment for Stanwick Lake, Northants.**

*To accompany the "generic risk assessment" and "sessional event plan" containing a dynamic risk assessment on the day.*

*Carried out via telephone conversation to lake owner Phil Dunn on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2009 in advance of visit on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2009*

### **Advice received:**

Risk: Slippery pegs and bank

Risk level: Dependent on weather but assumed to be med/high

Action taken: Advise clients about the risk / place grit / dirt on slippery area to create grip / ask clients to where footwear with good tread on / challenge "horse-play" near the waters edge.

Risk: One end of lake there is a syndicate car park:

Risk level: Low / medium depending on time of year / week. At this time of year and during office hours this risk is low due to reduced traffic.

Action taken: Clients have no reason to use this thoroughfare unaccompanied. If it is necessary to walk through this area a staff member will accompany the client.
