Car park and cars.	Participants and Coaches.	Low.	Safety talk. Constant supervision.	Park near to lakes. Walk on side of roads and be aware.
Drowning. (Deep water almost straight away in places. Particularly relevant to junior participants.)	Participants and coaches.	Low to medium.	Safety talk. First aid kit. Constant supervision. Throw ropes carried by coaches. Life rings round lake.	Gripped wellies or boots to prevent chance of slipping in. Coaches to have throw ropes on or near them at all times. Coaches to know where the nearest life rings are. Coaches to constantly keep an eye on participants.
Person hooking themselves. Banksides, swims and steps. (A lot of them are very steep and particularly slippery when wet.)	Participants and coaches.	Low to medium.	Safety talk. First aid kit.	Use barbless hooks. Always have disgorgers / forceps and an experienced coach ready. Use the least steep swims. Don't take juniors down when icy or very wet.
Wooden steps. (Down the paths and in the swims.)	Participants and coaches.	Low to medium.	Safety talk and constant supervision.	Gripped wellies or boots. Make sure people take their time and don't mess about.
Wells disease and bugs.	Participants and coaches.	Low.	Safety talk and constant supervision.	Make sure no cuts or open wounds, especially on hands. (If there are, make sure suitably protected. Wash hands thoroughly before eating and after fishing.)
