Kitchen / Cafeteria area. (Hot food, hot drinks, cutlery, Food waste bins, Kitchen itself with the usual hazards a kitchen will contain.) Dirty hands after cleaning bird aviaries and handling birds and protective equipment.	Coaches and participants.	Medium.	Safety talk and constant supervision.	No one is to go in the actual kitchen area itself. Everyone is to remain sensible and take time in the cafeteria area. No putting hands into the food waste bins. Everyone is to wash hands before eating and when the session is finished at the end.
General public.	Coaches and participants.	Low.	Safety talk and constant supervision.	Participants should not be allowed to approach members of the public by themselves. Coaches should at all times try and stay aware of any interactions between participants and general public.
Bird hospital. (Contains hazards such as medical drugs, cleaning of injured birds, operating instruments such as scalpels etc, chemicals and cleaning agents.)	Coaches and participants.	High.	Safety talk and constant supervision. Restricted access, training, display of C.O.S.H.H sheets, protective clothing, P.A.T testing.	The bird hospital is locked and on the whole will not be used by the coaches or participants.
