## **Areas to be looked at within the workshop:**

Warm Up Activities / Challenges - Juggling, Build a Tower / Contribute to improving your community / Activity improvisation / Financial Considerations - Interest Rates (borrowing), Purchasing Decisions, Break Even Analysis, Pricing / Idea Generation - Activity Ideas, Places to Visit Ideas / reviews, Ideas for learning, Cinema Reviews / Review and transfer of learning.

## **Course Length / Participants:**

The workshop lasts for one day with the potential to include a follow up activity leading to level 1 accreditation. Catering for a minimum of 100 participants, up to a whole year group. Students gain points for completing challenges which are converted into cash to be spent on sports Equipment for the local community (Subject to a budget for equipment being available).
